PRESENTATION

Located in the heart of the Vosges Mountains, in the Saint-Amarin valley, the Wesserling park is an essential stopover for anyone curious!

It is the largest Alsatian park listed as a **Historic Monument** and labeled "Remarkable Garden".

Its gardens are divided into 5 spaces:

- > the vegetable garden, where fruits and vegetables are grown in a fun way while respecting the environment.
- > the regular garden, with geometric paths offering a beautiful view of the castle.
- > the English park, which sublimates the wild nature.
- > the Mediterranean terraces, where in summer we find citrus fruits and laurels in pots.
- > the rural park, organic market gardening area and hay fields.

Each year, from June to October, the Festival des Jardins Métissés (mixed Gardens festival) promotes the heritage of Wesserling by inviting international artists. They draw their inspiration from the textile history of Wesserling and a particular theme defined each year for creating gigantic and ephemeral works!

A site influenced by industry...

A former textile factory, the Wesserling Park has managed to preserve an outstanding building collection linked to its heritage: castle, mansions, workshops, factories with shed roofs...

By exploring this heritage, you will discover an almost 300 year old epic between fashion, manufacturing techniques and worker's lives.

... but open to creativity

At the Wesserling Park, special spaces welcome creation: artists and craftsmen are keen to share their know-how and their originality. Gourmets will enjoy beer at the craft brewery, the fruit and vegetables from the vegetable garden and also the store of Saveurs et Couleurs de la Montagne producers, while fine products lovers will head to the jeweler who works with natural gem stones, or the furniture upholsterer, or the Bleu des Vosges textile store.

... and know-how transmitter

At the Textile Museum, demonstrations in period costume will introduce you to the manufacturing secrets of the famous printed fabrics called "Indiennes", which made Wesserling famous in the 18th century!

Surprising exhibitions are annually organized: between industrial history and contemporary textile creations, they will surely amaze you!





The safeguarding and refurbishment of the Wesserling Park continue!

The Parc de Wesserling wishes to refurbish two other history filled spaces: La Grande Chaufferie (former thermal power plant) and its outbuilding, the Turbines room and the Laboratory.

The overall project consists of creating a coherent ecomuseum visit following its own path, over the entire site, starting from the renovated castle. The discovery will be more complete, richer and therefore more attractive. Tourist attendance targets 150,000 visitors per year starting in the early years. This will produce strong positive impacts on the local economy.

These preserved spaces are part of the history of the Wesserling site, they bear witness to the technical and energy developments of this large textile factory and contribute to the understanding of the site as a whole.
